ANKAAA is the peak advocacy and support agency for Aboriginal artists and art centres in the Kimberley, Tiwi Islands, Arnhem, Katherine and Darwin regions



UMI Arts is the peak Indigenous arts and cultural organisation for Far North Queensland. UMI Arts is a not-for-profit company managed by an all Indigenous Board of Directors

Desart, Association of Northern, Kimberley and Arnhem Aboriginal Artists (ANKAAA), Ananguku Arts and Culture (Ananguku Arts) and UMI Arts are the leading peak bodies for Indigenous artists and Indigenous owned art centres in northern and central Australia.

Together they represent more than 100 Indigenous owned art centres which include more than 5,000 Indigenous artists. A significant proportion of Australia's Indigenous art is produced in these art centres and they represent some of Australia's leading contemporary artists.

Desart, ANKAAA, Ananguku Arts and UMI Arts are key organisations within the Indigenous art industry and have established national profiles. They provide a strong voice for their members to advocate and influence policy as well as educate people about Indigenous Australian art and ethical practices in its production and sale. Desart, ANKAAA and UMI Arts contributed to the development of the [Indigenous Australian Art Commercial Code of Conduct](#).

Desart, ANKAAA, Ananguku Arts and UMI Arts also play a key role in industry, economic and community development providing services to their members including training, professional development, information and resources as well as governance, business development and marketing support.
